| I may visit you tomorrow. | I may not visit you tomorrow. | May I visit you tomorrow? | Yes, you may. No, you may not. |
| You can repeat it. | You can not repeat it. | Can you repeat it? | Yes, I can. No, I can not. |
| He should be in school. | He should not be in school. | Should he be in school? | Yes, he should. No, he should not. |
| She would like coffee. | She would not like coffee. | Would she like coffee? | Yes, she would. No, she would not. |
| It might rain tonight. | It might not rain tonight. | Might it rain tonight? | Yes, it might. No, it might not. |
| We shall come with you. | We shall not come with you. | Shall we come with you? | Yes, you shall. No, you shall not. |
| You could help me. | You could not help me. | Could you help me? | Yes, we could. No, we could not. |
